**We all know that native pedigree pork produces the best-tasting bangers – and now's the chance to prove it.**

**At this year's Jimmy's Festival, hosted by RBST President Jimmy Doherty, we will be launching a competition to find the best-tasting pedigree native breed sausages. The competition is open to any producer and your sausages can use any meat – pork, beef or lamb – providing it comes from a registered pedigree animal from the RBST Watchlist categories 1 to 6.**

This is a chance for small producers to really shine and show what great products come from our wonderful native breeds. The competition has the backing of our partners, Jimmy's Farm, Slow Food UK, the British Pig Association and the British Lop Pig Society, who will all ensure that the winners get some great publicity.

All entries will be judged by Jimmy and his expert panel and the results announced at Jimmy's Festival on 22 July 2017. The winner will receive a three-star Gold Award and all approved entries will be entitled to use the RBST Supporter's logo on their products until the end of 2018. All entrants will also be included on all RBST and BPA approved producer lists.

There is an entry fee of £24 per product and all proceeds will go to the RBST Gene Bank Appeal for pigs. Get your entry in soon – but please don't send us any sausages yet! Closing date for receipt of entry forms – 3 July 2017.

- 3 If you plan to attend the award judging, your products must still arrive by the above deadline.
- 4 It is the responsibility of the entrant
- 5 All products must be made to the same standard and recipe as those normally available for sale. Any batches made specifically for judging will be disqualified. Only entries fit for consumption will be judged and any products arriving in a damaged or unsafe condition will be disqualified.
