The good news is that the number of members with registered pigs has increased from 24 to 34. For the future survival of the breed we need to have more breeders. One of the main risks we face at present is that the loss of one or two larger herds could have a devastating effect. Numbers of sows have held up at 200. The Aurora, Dina, Hera and Sheila sow lines are no longer present. Of the 40 remaining lines we will identify the more traditional lines and focus attention on these.

The Hawk line is back in the survey. The Dromus, Notis and Riber lines are not showing in the survey but there are Dromus litters on the ground and we will be looking to bring a send a boar to AI this year. The other two lines are both available as frozen semen and can be brought back into the herd as part of a conservation breeding programme. The same applies to the Esmer line which is not showing this year.
