



## Active Pedigree Breed Representative Election 2025

To be eligible to stand as a breed rep you must be a member in good standing who has birth notified at least 10 litters of pigs of that breed during the qualifying period of 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025.

If you meet the qualifying criteria and eligibility, you have the time and the skills to meet the requirements of the Job Description you may apply for a role.

There is no requirement to obtain any nomination from another Breeder before you apply,

Your application should include a 500 word summary as to why you believe you qualify for and should be elected into the role.

Any breed that has more than two candidates will have an election.

A maximum of 2 breed-reps per breed will be elected with the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes being elected to the roles. All breeders with that breed of pig will have a chance to vote.

Can there be more than one Active Pedigree Breeder from one herd?

No Although many members choose to list their herds under Joint names only one person can be the Active Pedigree Breeder associated with that herd and that membership. Each person standing for election must have their own membership and qualify as an Active Pedigree Breeder in their own right.
