Analysis of Results

Over the past 3 year period survey figures have remained fairly stable with no significant changes in the overall number of members keeping Duroc pigs and in the number of breeding sows.

Overall the number of registered boars has decreased slightly, but when reviewing the individual bloodlines this is not of concern.

Previous focus on boar lines with low numbers such as Next Level, has been successful and has increased the No of registered boars and the spread across herds.

Thunder currently appears to be low in numbers, however a young proven boar is coming up to available and there are plans for further distribution of this bloodline .

Likewise focus on female lines with low numbers has been proactive over the past 2 years with expectations to increase the number of these lines across herds (Hover and Tornetoft).

Whilst there are 17 members keeping Duroc pigs, not all of these are active breeding herds with several members keeping Durocs on a purely commercial/terminal boar basis.

Target

As breed reps we will engage with and determine which members are interested proactively work on supporting specific bloodlines and increasing the distribution of these with a particular focus on birth notified bloodlines suitable for bringing into the registered herd.
