Summary of Results:

The Pauline female line has declined by 45, while male Merry lines have reduced by 14. Several lines are now critically endangered, with very low numbers recorded. Among females, Sarah, Sluizenweg Ella and Greta each have only one remaining individual. Male lines at risk include Andrew, Fibert, Goliat, Milan, Obertus, Panpan and Vanfred with one each, and Moker and Wadrif with two each. The population remains heavily concentrated in the North, with limited presence elsewhere. There are currently 19 members with registered boars and 97 registered sows. While the total number of sows has decreased, boar lines have increased overall. Six registered boar lines have been lost, although no female lines have been lost.

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Targets:

1. Increase overall sow numbers to reverse the current decline.
2. Prioritise the recovery and preservation of critically endangered female and male lines through targeted breeding.
3. Maintain and further strengthen the diversity of boar lines while preventing additional losses.
4. Expand geographical distribution, particularly into Wales and Northern Ireland.
5. Encourage wider participation among members to support breeding and registration efforts.
